The College President and administration are responsible for acting on curriculum proposals, including making recommendations to the Board of Trustees, the Coordinating Board for Higher Education, the Higher Learning Commission (HLC), and/or the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, as applicable. Curriculum decisions are consistent with major curricular goals and the strategic plan of the College.

The College Curriculum reflects the primary learning outcomes for programs of study and courses and demonstrates that learning outcomes have been clearly defined for each course and/or program of study as they relate to the College mission and purposes.
