- Additional courses that can be completed at TRCC which will transfer to SEMO toward your degree are:

 - MATH 163 College Algebra
- Determine two subject areas that you want to teach. Choose two from Math, Science, Language Arts or Social Studies.
 - **Math** – Take the following TRCC courses for transfer to SEMO towards your degree:
 - MATH 170 Applied Calculus
 - MATH 211 Discrete Mathematics
 - MATH 223 Probability & Statistics
 - **Science** – Take the following TRCC courses for transfer to SEMO toward your degree:
 - CHEM 111 Introduction to Chemistry
 - PHYS 150 Environmental Geology
 - BIOL 211 General Botany -or- BIOL 102 Environmental Science –or- BIOL 221 General Zoology
 - **Social Studies** – Take the following TRCC courses for transfer to SEMO towards your degree:
 - 2nd History course – choose between:
HIST 111 American History to 1877 -or-
HIST 112 American History since 1877
 - HIST 211 The United States since 1945
 - HIST 121 World Civilization to the Renaissance
 - HIST 122 World Civilization since the Renaissance
 - One Geography course - choose from:
GEOG 111 Regional World Geography I -or-
GEOG 112 Regional World Geography II

• **Requirements for Admission to Teacher Education @ SEMO**

- Teacher Education candidates must not have any felony convictions
- Must not be on disciplinary probation at the university
- Must have 57 hours completed
- EN140 completed with a grade of "C" or above
- Block I completed with a written recommendation
