The Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) II provides emergency funding to colleges to assist students in need during the coronavirus pandemic. In 2020, this funding was known as the CARES Act Funding.

Three Rivers College has received HEERF II funding and has established the HEERF II CRRSAA Emergency Relief Fund to distribute grants to help cover expenses related to any component of the cost of attendance or an emergency cost due to coronavirus such as tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental), or child care.

Funds from the HEERF II CRRSAA Emergency Relief Fund are not considered financial aid and do not affect a student's current or future financial aid eligibility. Per guidance from the federal government, these grants will be distributed to our students who confirm that they have an exceptional need.

Eligible students will meet the following requirements:

You must be a U.S. citizen.

You must have attended Three Rivers College in the 2021 Spring semester

I verify I qualify for an exceptional need related to a component of the cost of attendance or an emergency cost due to coronavirus such as (tuition, food, housing, childcare, and health care, including mental).

- I authorize Three Rivers College to apply my eligible amount of HEERF II Funding to my Student Account.
