

Three Rivers College has received Supplemental Support under American Rescue Plan (SSARP) to serve students and ensure learning continues in the aftermath of the COVID-19 pandemic. These grants can help cover emergency costs that arise due to the coronavirus related to any component of the cost of attendance or an emergency cost due to coronavirus such as tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental), or childcare.

Funds from SSARP are not considered financial aid and do not affect a student's current or future financial aid eligibility. Per guidance from the federal government, these grants will be distributed to our students who confirm that they have an exceptional need.

Eligible students will meet the following requirements:

- Be registered and attending classes at the time of application submission. Students who are withdrawn from all courses through as No Shows will no longer be eligible.
- Priority will be given to students with exceptional need based on EFC of 0-6206 as indicated by the 2022-2023 FAFSA application.
- Applications will be accepted August 29, 2022 through September 23, 2022 and funding amounts are anticipated to be determined and awarded the following week.
